Opening of an application process to select and recruit doctoral candidates under Article 23 of Decree-Law no. 57/2016, of August 29, amended by Law No. 57/2017 of July 19..

- 1 At a meeting on September 26, 2018, the Scientific Board decided to open an international application process for 1 doctoral position to carry out research activities in the 3rd Group areas General Legal Sciences and Related (cf. the list of subjects included in Order no. 6444/2015, published in the portuguese 'Diário da República', 2nd series, no. 111, of June 9, 2015) under Labor Code legislation, in Universidade Nova de Lisboa- Law School (from now on referred to as NOVA Direito). 2- The call for applications as well as the Jury selection, was authorized following the administrative Order of 17/01/2019 by the Dean of Universidade Nova de Lisboa, being the doctorate's payment dependent on the prior sending of the respective amount by the public authorities that legally assume this financial burden.
- 2 The doctorate's hiring will be done under Decree-Law no. 57/2016, of August 29, as amended by Law no. 57/2017 of July 19, which approves a hiring regime of doctorates to stimulate scientific and technological employment in all areas of knowledge (RJEC), and the Labor Code, approved by Law no. 7/2009, of February 12, in its current version.
- 3 The application process is opened under article 23, paragraph 1, of the Legal Regime of Scientific Employment (RJEC in the original Portuguese) for doctorate fellows who meet the requirements to the date of 31 December 2017.
- 4 Pursuant to article 5 of Regulatory Decree N.º 11-A/2017, of December 29, the contracts that will be celebrated are remunerated according to level 33 of Single Remuneration Table (TRU in the original Portuguese), without prejudice to the no. 3 of the same Article.
- 5 The work place is based at the premises of NOVA Direito, Campus de Campolide, 1099-032 Lisboa.
- 6 It may be accepted on the competition national, foreigners and stateless candidates who hold a doctorate degree in General Legal Sciences and Related. If the doctorate has been awarded by a foreign higher education institution, it must be in accordance to the Decree-Law no. 341/2007, of October 12, to the date of the deadline for the application.
- 7 The selection of the researcher takes place through the evaluation of the scientific and curricular path of the candidates. In generic terms, this evaluation focuses on relevance, quality and modernity of:
 - (a) Scientific output of the last five years considered more relevant by the applicant;
- b) Applied or practice-based research activities developed over the last five years and considered to have the greatest impact by the candidate;
- c) Extension and dissemination of knowledge activities developed in the last five years, namely in the context of culture promotion and scientific practices considered by the candidate to be more relevant:
- d) Management activities of science, technology and innovation programs or of the experience in observing and monitoring the scientific and technological system or higher education in Portugal or abroad.
- 8 The period of five years referred to in the previous paragraph may be increased by the Jury, by request of the candidate, in case of the scientific activity was suspended for socially protected reasons, in particular for reasons of parental leave, serious prolonged illness, and other legally protected situations of work unavailability.
 - 9 The candidates' classification system is expressed on a scale of 0 to 100 points.
- 10 The research activity will be developed within the framework of the Center for Research and Development on Law and Society (CEDIS in the original Portuguese), NOVA Direito.
- 11 In the selection contest scope, the call listed below is valid for application, and expires when filled, being next described the place, the evaluation criteria and the respective jury.

12 - This place is designed to develop research activities and knowledge dissemination, under the guidance of the CEDIS Board of Directors in General Legal Sciences and Related, with the aim to contribute to the progress of CEDIS research, in the different aspects of its strategic project.

The place is opened pursuant to paragraph 1 of Article 23 of the RJEC, in particular by taking into account the fellowship with reference SFRH/ BPD/ 101779/2014.

- 13 The criteria for the evaluation and ranking of the candidates are as follows:
- (a) the variety and quality of the scientific, technological, cultural or artistic production of the last five years considered to be more relevant by the candidate (55%);
- b) The variety and quality of applied or practice-based research activities developed over the last five years and considered to be of greatest impact by the candidate (15%);
- c) The variety and quality of the activities of extension and dissemination of knowledge developed in the last five years, in particular in the context of culture promotion and scientific practices, considered by the candidate to be more relevant (15%);
- d) The variety and quality of management activities of science, technology and innovation programs, or of experience in the observation and monitoring of the scientific and technological system or of higher education, in Portugal or abroad (15%).
 - 14 In accordance with Article 13 of the RJEC, the Jury is composed by:
- Chair: Professor Mariana França Gouveia, Associate Professor with Aggregation at NOVA Direito

Effective vowels:

- Professor Jorge Bacelar Gouveia, Full Professor and Chair of the Scientific Council at NOVA Direito:
 - Professor Cristina Maria Machado de Queiroz Leitão, Professor at NOVA Direito;
- Professor Armando Marques Guedes, Associate Professor with Aggregation at NOVA Direito and CEDIS Director.
- 15 The application process to the place mentioned above should be accompanied, under penalty of exclusion, by the following documentation, which must be delivered in digital format, namely in two pen drives:
 - a) Application form, with explicit mention of the competition procedure to which is applying;
- b) Copies of the certificate proving the doctorate degree and the candidate's curriculum, organized according to the information on the present Notice concerning the "evaluation of the scientific and curricular background" of the place;
- c) Copies of the three publications considered most relevant by the candidate, associated with the place;
- d) Research project proposal, including scientific publication plan, dissemination activity and competitive national and international funding for the place that is applying (up to a maximum of 10 pages).
- 16 Applications, duly instructed with the documents mentioned above, must be delivered within 30 business days at NOVA Direito from the day immediately after the publication of this Notice in the Portuguese "Diário da República", or sent by registered post until the last day of the deadline, to the following address: NOVA Direito, Campus de Campolide, 1099-032 Lisboa.
- 17 Candidates who do not obtain a final mark equal to or greater than 50 points will not be allowed to fill any of the places in the competition, due to lack of absolute merit.
- 18 The hiring of the winners of each one of the places in the contest is conditioned upon its budgetary adjustment, through financing by FCT and through a contract program between FCT and NOVA Direito.
