

RECTOR'S ORDER No. 94/2022

Considering the current humanitarian crisis arising from the armed conflict experienced in Ukraine and, within the scope of the temporary protection measures approved by national legislation to support refuge people, it is necessary to safeguard the concrete situation of students and other Ukrainian citizens who request the services of the Nova University, Lisbon (NOVA).

Thus, in line with Articles 3 and 6 of Portuguese Decree-Law (DL) No. 24-B/2022, of March 11, and with Portuguese Article 2 of Decree-Law (DL) No. 28-A/2022, of 25 of March, in conjunction with the Resolution of the Council of Ministers n.º 29-A/2022, of March 1<sup>st</sup>, I hereby determine:

- a) Exemption from tuition fees and emoluments for students in an emergency situation, for humanitarian reasons, from Ukraine enrolled in degree-granting courses taught by NOVA, provided that this exemption is requested by the student, evoking their refugee status;
- b) Exemption from fees in requests for recognition of foreign academic degrees requested to NOVA by citizens in an emergency situation, for humanitarian reasons, coming from Ukraine.

This Rector's Order has immediate application.
